Jeremiah 26:19. Did Hezekiah the king of Judah and all those of Judah by any means put him to death? Did he not fear Yehowah and proceed to soften the face of Yehowah, so that Yehowah got to feeling regret for the calamity that he had spoken against them? So we are working up a great calamity against our souls.

- However, Hezekiah humbled himself for the haughtiness of his heart, he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and Yehowah's indignation did not come upon them in the days of Hezekiah. (2 Chronicles 32:26)
- And Yehowah began to feel regret over the evil that he had spoken of doing to his people. (Exodus 32:14)
- And the angel kept his hand thrust out toward Jerusalem to bring it to ruin, and Yehowah began to feel regret over the calamity, and so he said to the angel that was bringing ruin among the people; It is enough! - And you must not pollute the land in which you are, because it is blood that pollutes the land, and for the land there may be no atonement respecting the blood that has been spilled upon it except by the blood of the one spilling it. (Numbers 35:33)
- But if it is from God, you will not be able to overthrow them, otherwise, you may perhaps be found fighters actually against God. (Acts of Apostles 5:39)
- If you will without fail keep dwelling in this land, I will also build you up and I shall not tear you down, and I will plant you and I shall not uproot you, for I shall certainly feel regret over the calamity that I have caused to you. (Jeremiah 42:10)
- And Bethel proceeded to send Sharezer and Regem-melech and his men to soften the face of Yehowah. (Zechariah 7:2)
- And now, please, soften the face of God, that he may show us favor. From Your hand this has occurred. Will he receive any of You men kindly? Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 1:9)
