Jeremiah 26:23... And they proceeded to bring Urijah out from Egypt and to bring him to King Jehoiakim, who then struck him down with the sword and cast his dead body into the graveyard of the sons of the people.

- To no effect I have struck your sons. No discipline did they take. Your sword has devoured your prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin. (Jeremiah 2:30)
- Therefore you are bearing witness against yourselves that you are sons of those who murdered the prophets. (Matthew 23:31)
- Who killed even the Lord Jesus and the prophets and persecuted us. Furthermore, they are not pleasing God, but are against the interests of all men. (1 Thessalonians 2:15)
