Jeremiah 26:5. By listening to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I am sending to you, even rising up early and sending them, whom you have not listened to.

[8] - References:

- And Yehowah kept warning Israel and Judah by means of all his prophets and every visionary, saying; Turn back from Your bad ways and keep my commandments, my statutes, according to all the Law that I commanded Your forefathers and that I have sent to You by means of my servants the prophets. (2 Kings 17:13)
- And now for the reason that you kept doing all these works, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I kept speaking to you, getting up early and speaking, but you did not listen, and I kept calling you, but you did not answer. (Jeremiah 7:13)
- For I solemnly admonished YOUR forefathers in the day of my bringing them up out of the land of Egypt and down to this day, rising up early and admonishing, saying; Obey my voice.

 (Jeremiah 11:7)
- From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon, the king of Judah, and down to this day, these twenty-three years the word of Yehowah has occurred to me, and I kept speaking to you people, rising up early and speaking, but you did not listen. (Jeremiah 25:3)
- Due to the fact that they have not listened to my words, is the utterance of Yehowah, that I have sent to them with my servants the prophets, getting up early and sending them. But you have not listened, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:19)
- And they kept turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a rising up early and teaching, but there were none of them listening to receive discipline. (Jeremiah 32:33)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah, the God of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the calamity that I have spoken against them, for the reason that I have spoken to them but they did not listen, and I kept calling to them but they did not answer. (Jeremiah 35:17)

And I kept sending to you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending, saying; Do not do, please, this detestable sort of thing that I have hated. (Jeremiah 44:4)
