Jeremiah 27:14. And do not listen to the words of the prophets that are saying to you men; You will not serve the king of Babylon, because falsehood is what they are prophesying to you.

- Where, now, are Your prophets who prophesied to You, saying;
 The king of Babylon will not come against You men and against this land? (Jeremiah 37:19)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- I did not send the prophets, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (Jeremiah 23:21)
- And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah has not sent you, but you yourself have caused this people to trust in a falsehood. (Jeremiah 28:15)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Let not YOUR prophets who are in among YOU and YOUR practicers of divination deceive YOU, and do not YOU listen to their dreams that they are dreaming. (Jeremiah 29:8)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Woe to the stupid prophets, who are walking after their own spirit, when there is nothing that they have seen! (Ezekiel 13:3)
- Your own prophets have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things; And they have not uncovered your error in order to turn back your captivity; But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (Lamentations 2:14)
- By reason of dejecting the heart of a righteous one with falsehood, when I myself had not caused him pain, and for making the hands of a wicked one strong so that he would not turn back from his bad way in order to preserve him alive. (Ezekiel 13:22)
