

**Jeremiah 27:22** To Babylon is where they will be brought and there they will continue to be until the day of my turning my attention to them, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will bring them up and restore them to this place.

- And the pillars of copper that were in the house of Yehowah, and the carriages and the copper sea that were in the house of Yehowah, the Chaldeans broke in pieces and went carrying the copper of them to Babylon. (2 Kings 25:13)
- And all the utensils, great and small, of the house of the true God and the treasures of the house of Yehowah and the treasures of the king and of his princes, everything he brought to Babylon. (2 Chronicles 36:18)
- And the cans and the shovels and the extinguishers and the bowls and the cups and all the copper utensils with which they used to minister they took. (Jeremiah 52:18)
- At that time they brought in the vessels of gold that they had taken away from the temple of the house of God that was in Jerusalem, and from them the king and his grandees, his concubines and his secondary wives drank. (Daniel 5:3)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (2 Chronicles 36:21)
- Also, King Cyrus himself brought forth the utensils of the house of Yehowah, which Nebuchadnezzar had brought out from Jerusalem and then put in the house of his god. (Ezra 1:7)
- For this is what Yehowah has said, In accord with the fulfilling of seventy years at Babylon I shall turn my attention to you people, and I will establish toward you my good word in bringing you back to this place. (Jeremiah 29:10)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)
- And also the gold and silver vessels of the house of God that Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple, which was in

Jerusalem, and **brought** to the temple of Babylon, these Cyrus the king took out of the temple of Babylon, and they were given to Sheshbazzar, the name of the one whom he made governor. (**Ezra 5:14**)

- And the vessels that are being given to you for the service of the house of your God deliver in full before God at Jerusalem. (**Ezra 7:19**)
- For, look! There are **days** coming, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, and I **will** gather the captive ones of my people, Israel and Judah, **Yehowah** has said, and I **will bring** them back to the land that I gave to their forefathers, and they **will** certainly repossess it. (**Jeremiah 30:3**)
- And to Babylon he **will** take Zedekiah, and there he **will continue until** I turn my **attention** to him, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, although **you** men keep warring against the Chaldeans, **you will** not succeed? (**Jeremiah 32:5**)
