Jeremiah 27:3. And you must send them to the king of Edom and to the king of Moab and to the king of the sons of Ammon and to the king of Tyre and to the king of Sidon by the hand of the messengers who are coming to Jerusalem to Zedekiah¹ the king of Judah.

- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that Edom has acted in taking vengeance upon the house of Judah and they kept doing wrong extensively and avenged themselves on them. (Ezekiel 25:12)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Tyre, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their handing over a complete body of exiles to Edom, and because they did not remember the covenant of brothers. (Amos 1:9)
- The vision of Obadiah; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said regarding Edom; There is a report that we have heard from Yehowah, and there is an envoy that has been sent among the nations, Rise up, YOU people, and let us rise up against her in battle. (Obadiah 1:1)
- As regards Mesha the king of Moab, he became a sheep raiser, and he paid to the king of Israel a hundred thousand lambs and a hundred thousand unshorn male sheep. (2 Kings 3:4)
- For Moab this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Woe to Nebo, for she has been despoiled! Kiriathaim has been put to shame, has been captured. The secure height has been put to shame and been put in terror. (Jeremiah 48:1)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that Moab and Seir have said; Look! The house of Judah is like all the other nations. (Ezekiel 25:8)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Moab, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of his burning the bones of the king of Edom for lime. (Amos 2:1)
- Edom and Moab and the sons of Ammon. (Jeremiah 25:21)

- For the sons of Ammon this is what Yehowah has said; Are there no sons that Israel has, or is there no inheritor that he has? Why is it that Malcam has taken possession of Gad, and his own people have taken up dwelling in Israel's very cities? (Jeremiah 49:1)
- Son of man, set your face toward the sons of Ammon and prophesy against them. (Ezekiel 25:2)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of the sons of Ammon, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their slitting open the pregnant women of Gilead, for the purpose of widening out their own territory. (Amos 1:13)
- The pronouncement of Tyre! Howl, You ships of Tarshish! For it has been despoiled from being a port, from being a place to enter in. From the land of Kittim it has been revealed to them. (Isaiah 23:1)
- On account of the day that is coming to despoil all the Philistines, to cut off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping. For Yehowah is despoiling the Philistines, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (Jeremiah 47:4)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Tyre, and I will bring up against you many nations, just as the sea brings up its waves. (Ezekiel 26:3)
- And I will send a fire onto the wall of Tyre, and it must devour her dwelling towers. (Amos 1:10)
- And Tyre proceeded to build a rampart for herself, and to pile up silver like dust and gold like the mire of the streets. (Zechariah 9:3)
- Be ashamed, O Sidon, because the sea, O you stronghold of the sea, has said; I have not had birth pains, and I have not given birth, nor have I brought up young men, raised up virgins. (Isaiah 23:4)
- And all the kings of Tyre and all the kings of Sidon and the kings of the island that is in the region of the sea. (Jeremiah 25:22)
- Son of man, set your face toward Sidon, and prophesy against her. (Ezekiel 28:21)

- And, also, what do you have to do with me, O Tyre and Sidon and all you regions of Philistia? Is it the treatment that you are giving me as a reward? And if you are giving such treatment to me, swiftly, speedily I shall pay back your treatment upon your heads. (Joel 3:4)
- Upon Egypt and upon Judah and upon Edom and upon the sons of Ammon and upon Moab and upon all those with hair clipped at the temples who are dwelling in the wilderness, for all the nations are uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel are uncircumcised in heart. (Jeremiah 9:26)
- And I proceeded to take the cup out of the hand of Yehowah and to make all the nations drink to whom Yehowah had sent me.

 (Jeremiah 25:17)
- And their king must go into exile, he and his princes together, Yehowah has said. (Amos 1:15)
