

**Jeremiah 27:8** And it must occur that the nation and the kingdom that will not serve him, even Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and the one that will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, with the sword and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah; until I shall have finished them off by his hand.

- And Zedekiah's sons they slaughtered before his eyes, and Zedekiah's eyes he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters and brought him to **Babylon**. (**2 Kings 25:7**)
- The one sitting still in this city **will** die by the **sword** and by the **famine** and by the **pestilence**, but the one who is going out and who actually falls away to the Chaldeans who are laying siege against **you will** keep living, and his soul **will** certainly come to be his as a spoil. (**Jeremiah 21:9**)
- It must also **occur** that the very **sword** of which **you** are afraid **will** there catch up with **you** in the land of Egypt, and the very **famine** at which **you** are in a fright **will** there closely follow after **you** to Egypt, and there is where **you will** die. (**Jeremiah 42:16**)
- Your dependent towns in the field he **will** kill **even** with the **sword**, and he must make against you a siege wall and throw up against you a siege rampart and raise up against you a large shield. (**Ezekiel 26:8**)
- On the ninth day of the fourth month the **famine** was severe in the city, and there proved to be no bread for the people of the land. (**2 Kings 25:3**)
- Better **have** those slain with the **sword** proved to be than those slain by **famine**, because these pine away, pierced through for lack of the produce of the open field. (**Lamentations 4:9**)
- Look! With siege ramparts men **have** come to the city to capture it, and the very city **will** certainly be given into the **hand** of the Chaldeans who are fighting against it, because of the **sword** and the **famine** and the **pestilence**, and what you **have** said has happened, and here you are seeing it. (**Jeremiah 32:24**)

- And I **will** send against them the **sword**, the **famine** and the **pestilence**, until they come to their finish off the ground that I gave to them and to their forefathers. (**Jeremiah 24:10**)
- And it came about in the ninth year of his being **king**, in the tenth month on the tenth day of the month, that **Nebuchadnezzar** the **king** of **Babylon** came, yes, he and all his military force, against Jerusalem and began camping against it and building against it a siege wall all around. (**2 Kings 25:1**)
- This is what **Yehowah** of armies, the God of Israel, has said; I **will** break the **yoke** of the **king** of **Babylon**. (**Jeremiah 28:2**)
