Jeremiah 28:11. And Hananiah went on to say before the eyes of all the people; This is what Yehowah has said; Just like this I shall break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon within two full years more from off the neck of all the nations. And Jeremiah the prophet proceeded to go his way.

- Then it came about in that year, in the beginning of the kingdom of Zedekiah the king of Judah, in the fourth year, in the fifth month, that Hananiah the son of Azzur, the prophet who was from Gibeon, said to me in the house of Yehowah before the eyes of the priests and of all the people. (Jeremiah 28:1)
- At this he said to him; I too am a prophet like you, and an angel himself spoke to me by the word of Yehowah, saying, Have him come back with you to your house that he may eat bread and drink water. He deceived him. (1 Kings 13:18)
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and said; This is what Yehowah has said; With these you will push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (2 Chronicles 18:10)
- They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me; Yehowah has spoken; Peace is what you people will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his heart they have said; No calamity will come upon you people. (Jeremiah 23:17)
- For it is in falsehood that they are prophesying to You in my name. I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:9)
- And Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim, the king of Judah, and all the exiles of Judah who have come to Babylon I am bringing back to this place, is the utterance of Yehowah, for I shall break the yoke of the king of Babylon. (Jeremiah 28:4)
- Go away from in front of the stupid man, for you will certainly not take note of the lips of knowledge. (Proverbs 14:7)
- Do not answer anyone stupid according to his foolishness, that you yourself also may not become equal to him. (Proverbs 26:4)

- However, the prophet who presumes to speak in my name a word that I have not commanded him to speak or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet must die. (Deuteronomy 18:20)
- And as for you men, do not listen to your prophets and to your practicers of divination and to your dreamers and to your practicers of magic and to your sorcerers, who are saying to you; You men will not serve the king of Babylon. (Jeremiah 27:9)
