

**Jeremiah 28:11** And Hananiah went on to say before the eyes of all the people; This is what Yehowah has said; Just like this I shall break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon within two full years more from off the neck of all the nations. And Jeremiah the prophet proceeded to go his way.

- Then it came about in that year, in the beginning of the kingdom of Zedekiah the **king** of Judah, in the fourth year, in the fifth month, that Hananiah the son of Azzur, the **prophet** who was from Gibeon, **said** to me in the house of **Yehowah** before the eyes of the priests and of all the **people**. (**Jeremiah 28:1**)
- At this he **said** to him; I too am a **prophet** like you, and an angel himself spoke to me by the word of **Yehowah**, saying, Have him come back with you to your house that he may eat bread and drink water. He deceived him. (**1 Kings 13:18**)
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and **said**; **This is what Yehowah has said**; With these you will push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (**2 Chronicles 18:10**)
- They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me; Yehowah **has** spoken; Peace is **what you people** will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his heart they have **said**; No calamity will come upon **you** people. (**Jeremiah 23:17**)
- For it is in falsehood that they are prophesying to **you** in my name. I have not sent them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 29:9**)
- And Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim, the **king** of Judah, and all the exiles of Judah who have come to **Babylon** I am bringing back to this place, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, for I shall **break** the **yoke** of the **king** of **Babylon**. (**Jeremiah 28:4**)
- Go away from in front of the stupid man, for you will certainly not take note of the lips of knowledge. (**Proverbs 14:7**)
- Do not answer anyone stupid according to his foolishness, that you yourself also may not become equal to him. (**Proverbs 26:4**)

- However, the **prophet** who presumes to speak in my name a word that I have not commanded him to speak or who speaks in the name of other gods, that **prophet** must die. (**Deuteronomy 18:20**)
- And as for **YOU** men, do not listen to **YOUR prophets** and to **YOUR** practicers of divination and to **YOUR** dreamers and to **YOUR** practicers of magic and to **YOUR** sorcerers, who are saying to **YOU**; **You** men will not serve the **king** of Babylon. (**Jeremiah 27:9**)
