

**Jeremiah 28:15** And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah has not sent you, but you yourself have caused this people to trust in a falsehood.

- Then it came about in that year, in the beginning of the kingdom of Zedekiah the king of Judah, in the fourth year, in the fifth month, that **Hananiah** the son of Azzur, the **prophet** who was from Gibeon, said to me in the house of **Yehowah** before the eyes of the priests and of all the **people**. (**Jeremiah 28:1**)
- In case a **prophet** or a dreamer of a dream arises in your midst and does give you a sign or a portent. (**Deuteronomy 13:1**)
- And **Yehowah** went on to **say** to me; Falsehood is what the **prophets** are prophesying in my name. I **have** not **sent** them, nor **have** I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to **you people**. (**Jeremiah 14:14**)
- I did not send the **prophets**, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (**Jeremiah 23:21**)
- For I **have** not **sent** them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, but they are prophesying in my name falsely, to the end that I shall disperse **you**, and **you** will **have** to perish, **you** men and the **prophets** that are prophesying to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:15**)
- Send to all the exiled **people**, saying; This is what **Yehowah** has said concerning Shemaiah of Nehelam; For the reason that Shemaiah **has** prophesied to **you people**, but I myself did not send him, and he tried to make **you** trust in **falsehood**. (**Jeremiah 29:31**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; Woe to the stupid **prophets**, who are walking after their own spirit, when there is nothing that they **have** seen! (**Ezekiel 13:3**)
- And it must occur that in case a man should prophesy anymore, his father and his mother, the ones who **caused** his birth, must also **say** to him, You will not live, because **falsehood** is what you **have** spoken in the name of Yehowah. And his father and his

mother, the ones who **caused** his birth, must pierce him through because of his prophesying. (**Zechariah 13:3**)

- Woe, whenever all men speak well of **you**, for things like these are what their forefathers did to the false **prophets**. (**Luke 6:26**)
- When the **prophet** speaks in the name of **Yehowah** and the word does not occur or come true, that is the word that **Yehowah** did not speak. With presumptuousness the **prophet** spoke it. You must not get frightened at him. (**Deuteronomy 18:22**)
- And as for you, O Pashhur, and all the inhabitants of your house, **you** will go into captivity, and to Babylon you will come and there you will die and there you yourself will be buried with all your lovers, because you **have** prophesied to them in **falsehood**. (**Jeremiah 20:6**)
- This is what **Yehowah** of armies **has** said; Do not listen to the words of the **prophets** who are prophesying to **you people**. They are making **you** become vain. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 23:16**)
- And do not listen to the words of the **prophets** that are saying to **you men**, **you** will not serve the king of Babylon, because **falsehood** is what they are prophesying to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:14**)
- For it is in **falsehood** that they are prophesying to **you** in my name. I **have** not **sent** them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 29:9**)
