Jeremiah 28:15. And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah has not sent you, but you yourself have caused this people to trust in a falsehood.

- Then it came about in that year, in the beginning of the kingdom of Zedekiah the king of Judah, in the fourth year, in the fifth month, that Hananiah the son of Azzur, the prophet who was from Gibeon, said to me in the house of Yehowah before the eyes of the priests and of all the people. (Jeremiah 28:1)
- In case a prophet or a dreamer of a dream arises in your midst and does give you a sign or a portent. (Deuteronomy 13:1)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- I did not send the prophets, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (Jeremiah 23:21)
- For I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah, but they are prophesying in my name falsely, to the end that I shall disperse you, and you will have to perish, you men and the prophets that are prophesying to you. (Jeremiah 27:15)
- Send to all the exiled people, saying; This is what Yehowah has said concerning Shemaiah of Nehelam; For the reason that Shemaiah has prophesied to you people, but I myself did not send him, and he tried to make you trust in falsehood. (Jeremiah 29:31)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Woe to the stupid prophets, who are walking after their own spirit, when there is nothing that they have seen! (Ezekiel 13:3)
- And it must occur that in case a man should prophesy anymore, his father and his mother, the ones who caused his birth, must also say to him, You will not live, because falsehood is what you have spoken in the name of Yehowah. And his father and his

- mother, the ones who caused his birth, must pierce him through because of his prophesying. (Zechariah 13:3)
- Woe, whenever all men speak well of YOU, for things like these are what their forefathers did to the false prophets. (Luke 6:26)
- When the prophet speaks in the name of Yehowah and the word does not occur or come true, that is the word that Yehowah did not speak. With presumptuousness the prophet spoke it. You must not get frightened at him. (Deuteronomy 18:22)
- And as for you, O Pashhur, and all the inhabitants of your house, you will go into captivity, and to Babylon you will come and there you will die and there you yourself will be buried with all your lovers, because you have prophesied to them in falsehood. (Jeremiah 20:6)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the words of the prophets who are prophesying to You people. They are making You become vain. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:16)
- And do not listen to the words of the prophets that are saying to you men, you will not serve the king of Babylon, because falsehood is what they are prophesying to you. (Jeremiah 27:14)
- For it is in falsehood that they are prophesying to you in my name. I have not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:9)
