

**Jeremiah 28:2**· This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

- And it must occur that the nation and the kingdom that **will** not serve him, even Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of **Babylon**, and the one that **will** not put its neck under the **yoke** of the **king** of **Babylon**, with the sword and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, until I shall have finished them off by his hand. (**Jeremiah 27:8**)
- Her own head ones judge merely for a bribe, and her own priests instruct just for a price, and her own prophets practice divination simply for money, yet upon **Yehowah** they keep supporting themselves, saying; Is not **Yehowah** in the midst of us? There **will** come upon us no calamity. (**Micah 3:11**)
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and **said**; This is what **Yehowah has said**, With these you **will** push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (**2 Chronicles 18:10**)
- And as for **YOU** men, do not listen to **YOUR** prophets and to **YOUR** practicers of divination and to **YOUR** dreamers and to **YOUR** practicers of magic and to **YOUR** sorcerers, who are saying to **YOU**; **You** men **will** not serve the **king** of Babylon. (**Jeremiah 27:9**)
- Where, now, are **YOUR** prophets who prophesied to **YOU**, saying; The **king** of **Babylon will** not come against **YOU** men and against this land? (**Jeremiah 37:19**)
