Jeremiah 28:2" This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

- And it must occur that the nation and the kingdom that will not serve him, even Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and the one that will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, with the sword and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah, until I shall have finished them off by his hand. (Jeremiah 27:8)
- Her own head ones judge merely for a bribe, and her own priests instruct just for a price, and her own prophets practice divination simply for money, yet upon Yehowah they keep supporting themselves, saying; Is not Yehowah in the midst of us? There will come upon us no calamity. (Micah 3:11)
- Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and said; This is what Yehowah has said, With these you will push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (2 Chronicles 18:10)
- And as for you men, do not listen to your prophets and to your practicers of divination and to your dreamers and to your practicers of magic and to your sorcerers, who are saying to you; You men will not serve the king of Babylon. (Jeremiah 27:9)
- Where, now, are YOUR prophets who prophesied to YOU, saying; The king of Babylon will not come against YOU men and against this land? (Jeremiah 37:19)
