- I do take as witnesses against **you** today the heavens and the earth, that **you** will positively perish in a hurry from off the land to which **you** are crossing the Jordan to take possession of it. **You** will not lengthen **YOUR** days on it, because **you** will positively be annihilated. (**Deuteronomy 4:26**)
- And it must occur that if you will not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (**Deuteronomy 28:15**)
- To that the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat; There is still one man through whom to inquire of Yehowah, but I myself certainly hate him, for he does not **prophesy** good things concerning me but bad, Micaiah the son of Imlah. However, Jehoshaphat said; Do not let the king say a thing like that. (**1 Kings 22:8**)
- When the word reached the king of Nineveh, then he rose up from his throne and put off his official garment from himself and covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the ashes. (**Jonah 3:6**)
