Jeremiah 29:10... For this is what Yehowah has said, In accord with the fulfilling of seventy years at Babylon I shall turn my attention to you people, and I will establish toward you my good word in bringing you back to this place.

[18] - References:

- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (2 Chronicles 36:21)
- And in the first year of Cyrus the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of Cyrus the king of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, saying; (Ezra 1:1)
- To Babylon is where they will be brought and there they will continue to be until the day of my turning my attention to them, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will bring them up and restore them to this place. (Jeremiah 27:22)
- In the first year of his reigning I myself, Daniel, discerned by the books the number of the years concerning which the word of Yehowah had occurred to Jeremiah the prophet, for fulfilling the devastations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years. (Daniel 9:2)
- So the angel of Yehowah answered and said; O Yehowah of armies, how long will you yourself not show mercy to Jerusalem and to the cities of Judah, whom you have denounced these seventy years? (Zechariah 1:12)
- Say to all the people of the land and to the priests; When you fasted and there was a wailing in the fifth month and in the seventh month, and this for seventy years, did you really fast to me, even me? (Zechariah 7:5)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)
- And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at

- Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah, each one to his own city. (Ezra 2:1)
- And I will set my eye upon them in a good way, and I shall certainly cause them to return to this land. And I will build them up, and I shall not tear down, and I will plant them, and I shall not uproot. (Jeremiah 24:6)
- But this is what Yehowah has said; Even the body of captives of the mighty man will be taken away, and those already taken by the tyrant himself will make their escape. And against anyone contending against you I myself shall contend, and your own sons I myself shall save. (Isaiah 49:25)
- For a little moment I left you entirely, but with great mercies I shall collect you together. (Isaiah 54:7)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said, Like these good figs, so I shall regard the exiles of Judah, whom I will send away from this place to the land of the Chaldeans, in a good way.

 (Jeremiah 24:5)
- And it must occur that when seventy years have been fulfilled I shall call to account against the king of Babylon and against that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah, their error, even against the land of the Chaldeans, and I will make it desolate wastes to time indefinite. (Jeremiah 25:12)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am gathering the captive ones of the tents of Jacob, and for his tabernacles I shall have pity. And the city will actually be rebuilt upon her mound, and upon its rightful site the dwelling tower itself will sit. (Jeremiah 30:18)
- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly carry out the good word that I have spoken, concerning the house of Israel and concerning the house of Judah. (Jeremiah 33:14)
- And there came to be another great eagle, having great wings, and having large pinions, and, look! This very vine stretched its roots hungrily toward him. And its foliage it thrust out to him in order for him to irrigate it, away from the garden beds where it was planted. (Ezekiel 17:7)

- And Yehowah proceeded to answer the angel who was speaking with me, with good words, comforting words. (Zechariah 1:13)
- But it was the tent of Moloch and the star of the god Rephan that YOU took up, the figures which YOU made to worship them.

 Consequently I will deport YOU beyond Babylon. (Acts of Apostles 7:43)
