Jeremiah 29:11" For I myself well know the thoughts that I am thinking toward you, is the utterance of Yehowah, thoughts of peace, and not of calamity, to give you a future and a hope.

- And he is in one mind, and who can resist him? And his own soul has a desire, and he will do it. (Job 23:13)
- To time indefinite the very counsel of Yehowah will stand, the thoughts of his heart are to one generation after another generation. (Psalms 33:11)
- Many things you yourself have done, O Yehowah my God, even your wonderful works and your thoughts toward us, there is none to be compared to you. Were I inclined to tell and speak of them, they have become more numerous than I can recount. (Psalms 40:5)
- Yehowah has removed the judgments upon you. He has turned away your enemy. The king of Israel, Yehowah, is in the midst of you. You will fear calamity no more. (Zephaniah 3:15)
- And there exists a hope for your future, is the utterance of Yehowah, and the sons will certainly return to their own territory. (Jeremiah 31:17)
- For in that case there will exist a future, and your own hope will not be cut off. (Proverbs 23:18)
- For I do not take any delight in the death of someone dying, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. So cause a turning back and keep living, O you people. (Ezekiel 18:32)
- And he had me pass along by them all round about, and, look! There were very many on the surface of the valley plain and, look! They were very dry. (Ezekiel 37:2)
- But as for them, they have not come to know the thoughts of Yehowah, and they have not come to understand his counsel, because he will certainly collect them together like a row of newly cut grain to the threshing floor. (Micah 4:12)

So I will again have in mind in these days to deal well with Jerusalem and with the house of Judah. Do not be afraid. (Zechariah 8:15)
