

**Jeremiah 29:12**· **And you will certainly call me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.**

[11] - References:

- The desire of the meek ones you **will certainly** hear, O Yehowah. You **will** prepare their heart. You **will** pay attention with your ear. (**Psalms 10:17**)
- When the very people in Zion **will** dwell in Jerusalem, you **will** by no means weep. He **will** without fail show you favor at the sound of your outcry, as soon as he hears it he **will** actually answer you. (**Isaiah 30:19**)
- And I proceeded to set my face to Yehowah the true God, in order to seek him with prayer and with entreaties, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. (**Daniel 9:3**)
- We know that God does not **listen** to sinners, but if anyone is God-fearing and does his **will**, he **listens** to this one. (**John 9:31**)
- And the sons of Israel began to **call** to Yehowah for aid. So Yehowah raised up for them a savior, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite, a left-handed man. In time the sons of Israel sent tribute by his hand to Eglon the king of Moab. (**Judges 3:15**)
- Therefore we fasted and made request of our God concerning this, so that he let himself be entreated by us. (**Ezra 8:23**)
- Call to me, and I shall answer you and readily tell you great and incomprehensible things that you have not known. (**Jeremiah 33:3**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; This is what I shall yet let myself be searched for by the house of Israel to do for them; I shall multiply them like a flock with men. (**Ezekiel 36:37**)
- I shall go, I **will** return to my place until they bear their guilt, and they **will certainly** seek my face. When they are in sore straits, they **will** seek me. (**Hosea 5:15**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Israel; Search for me, and keep living. (**Amos 5:4**)
