Jeremiah 29:12.. And you will certainly call me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.

[11] - References:

- The desire of the meek ones you will certainly hear, O Yehowah. You will prepare their heart. You will pay attention with your ear. (Psalms 10:17)
- When the very people in Zion will dwell in Jerusalem, you will by no means weep. He will without fail show you favor at the sound of your outcry, as soon as he hears it he will actually answer you. (Isaiah 30:19)
- And I proceeded to set my face to Yehowah the true God, in order to seek him with prayer and with entreaties, with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. (Daniel 9:3)
- We know that God does not listen to sinners, but if anyone is
 God-fearing and does his will, he listens to this one. (John 9:31)
- Yehowah raised up for them a savior, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite, a left-handed man. In time the sons of Israel sent tribute by his hand to Eglon the king of Moab. (Judges 3:15)

- Call to me, and I shall answer you and readily tell you great and incomprehensible things that you have not known. (Jeremiah 33:3)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; This is what I shall yet let myself be searched for by the house of Israel to do for them; I shall multiply them like a flock with men. (Ezekiel 36:37)
- I shall go, I will return to my place until they bear their guilt, and they will certainly seek my face. When they are in sore straits, they will seek me. (Hosea 5:15)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Israel; Search for me, and keep living. (Amos 5:4)
