

Jeremiah 29:13 **And you will actually seek me and find me, for you will search for me with all your heart.**

[13] - References:

- And they **will** certainly confess their own error and the error of their fathers in their unfaithfulness when they behaved unfaithfully toward me, yes, even when they walked in opposition to me. (**Leviticus 26:40**)
- And they indeed come to their senses in the land where they have been carried off captive, and they **actually** return and make request to you for favor in the land of their captors, saying; We have sinned and erred, we have acted wickedly. (**1 Kings 8:47**)
- Keep on asking, and it **will** be given **you**, keep on seeking, and **you will find**, keep on knocking, and it **will** be opened to **you**. (**Matthew 7:7**)
- If **you** do look for Yehowah your God from there, you **will** also certainly **find** him, because you **will** inquire for him with all your **heart** and with all your soul. (**Deuteronomy 4:29**)
- And you have returned to Yehowah your God and listened to his voice according to all that I am commanding you today, you and your sons, with all your **heart** and all your soul. (**Deuteronomy 30:2**)
- And they indeed return to you with all their **heart** and with all their soul in the land of their enemies who carried them off captive, and they indeed pray to you in the direction of their land that you gave to their forefathers, the city that you have chosen and the house that I have built to your name. (**1 Kings 8:48**)
- And I **will** give them a **heart** to know me, that I am Yehowah, and they must become my people, and I myself shall become their God, for they **will** return to me with all their **heart**. (**Jeremiah 24:7**)
- And they indeed return to you with all their **heart** and with all their soul in the land where they are captives of those who carried them off captive, and they indeed pray in the direction of their land that you gave to their forefathers and the city that you have chosen and the house that I have built to your name. (**2 Chronicles 6:38**)

- **Consequently he went out before Asa and said to him; Hear me, O Asa and all Judah and Benjamin! Yehowah is with **you** as long as **you** prove to be with him, and if **you** **search** for him, he **will** let himself be found by **you**, but if **you** leave him he **will** leave **you**. (2 Chronicles 15:2)**
- **Furthermore, they entered into a covenant to **search** for Yehowah the God of their forefathers with all their **heart** and with all their soul. (2 Chronicles 15:12)**
- **When **you** **will** have returned to me and kept my commandments and done them, though **your** dispersed people should happen to be at the end of the heavens, from there I shall collect them and certainly bring them to the place that I have chosen to have my name reside there. (Nehemiah 1:9)**
- **One thing I have asked from Yehowah. It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the house of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (Psalms 27:4)**
- **Happy are those observing his reminders, with all the **heart** they keep searching for him. (Psalms 119:2)**
