Jeremiah 29:14. And I will let myself be found by You, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will gather Your body of captives and collect You together out of all the nations and out of all the places to which I have dispersed You, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will bring You back to the place from which I caused You to go into exile.

- Yehowah our God is in all our calling upon him? (Deuteronomy 4:7)
- Search for Yehowah, you people, while he may be found. Call to him while he proves to be near. (Isaiah 55:6)
- If your dispersed people should be at the end of the heavens, from there Yehowah your God will collect you and from there he will take you. (Deuteronomy 30:4)
- But this is what Yehowah has said; Even the body of captives of the mighty man will be taken away, and those already taken by the tyrant himself will make their escape. And against anyone contending against you I myself shall contend, and your own sons I myself shall save. (Isaiah 49:25)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I will bring them back to their pasture ground, and they will certainly be fruitful and become many. (Jeremiah 23:3)
- For, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will gather the captive ones of my people, Israel and Judah, Yehowah has said, and I will bring them back to the land that I gave to their forefathers, and they will certainly repossess it. (Jeremiah 30:3)
- And they will have to know that I am Yehowah their God, when I send them in exile to the nations and actually bring them together upon their soil, so that I shall leave none of them remaining there any longer. (Ezekiel 39:28)
- For, look! In those days and in that time, when I shall bring back the captive ones of Judah and Jerusalem. (Joel 3:1)

- When Yehowah gathered back the captive ones of Zion, we became like those who were dreaming. (Psalms 126:1)
- Furthermore, O Judah, a harvest has been fixed for you, when I gather back the captive ones of my people. (Hosea 6:11)
- And I will gather back the captive ones of my people Israel, and they will actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (Amos 9:14)
- At that time I shall bring you people in, even in the time of my collecting you together. For I shall make you people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather back your captive ones before your eyes, Yehowah has said. (Zephaniah 3:20)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)
- For when you return to Yehowah, your brothers and your sons will be objects of mercy before those holding them captive, and be allowed to return to this land, for Yehowah your God is gracious and merciful, and he will not turn away the face from you if you return to him. (2 Chronicles 30:9)
- And in the first year of Cyrus the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of Cyrus the king of Persia, so that he caused a cry to pass through all his kingdom, and also in writing, saying; (2 Chronicles 36:22)
- And in the first year of Cyrus the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of Cyrus the king of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, saying; (Ezra 1:1)
- And whom he has collected together even from the lands, from the sunrise and from the sunset, from the north and from the south. (Psalms 107:3)
- And death will certainly be chosen rather than life on the part of all the remnant of those remaining out of this bad family in all

- the places of the remaining ones, where I will have dispersed them, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (Jeremiah 8:3)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall have dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I will bring them back to this place and make them dwell in security. (Jeremiah 32:37)
- To a good field, by vast waters, it was already transplanted, in order to produce boughs and to bear fruit, to become a majestic vine. (Ezekiel 17:8)
- And I shall no longer conceal my face from them, because I will pour out my spirit upon the house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 39:29)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they will feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they will lie stretched out. For Yehowah their God will turn his attention to them and certainly gather back the captive ones of them. (Zephaniah 2:7)
