

Jeremiah 29:16 For this is what Yehowah has said to the king sitting on the throne of David and to all the people dwelling in this city, **YOUR** brothers that have not gone forth with **you** into exile.

- And you must say; Hear the word of **Yehowah**, O **king** of Judah who are **sitting** on the **throne** of **David**, you with your servants and your **people**, those who are coming in through these gates. (**Jeremiah 22:2**)
- Then it came about in that year, in the beginning of the kingdom of Zedekiah the **king** of Judah, in the fourth year, in the fifth month, that Hananiah the son of Azzur, the prophet who was from Gibeon, **said** to me in the house of **Yehowah** before the eyes of the priests and of all the **people**. (**Jeremiah 28:1**)
- And he took into **exile** all Jerusalem and all the princes and all the valiant, mighty men, ten thousand he was taking into **exile**, and also every craftsman and builder of bulwarks. No one had been left behind except the lowly class of the **people** of the land. (**2 Kings 24:14**)
- And you must say to them; This is **what Yehowah has said**; Here I am filling all the inhabitants of this land and the **kings** that are **sitting** for **David** upon his **throne** and the priests and the prophets and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with drunkenness. (**Jeremiah 13:13**)
- And I will dash them one against another, both the fathers and the sons, at the same time, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. I shall show no compassion, nor feel any sorrow, and I shall not **have** the mercy to keep from bringing them to ruin. (**Jeremiah 13:14**)
