Jeremiah 29:20... And as for you, hear the word of Yehowah, all you exiled people, whom I have sent away from Jerusalem to Babylon.

- And he took into exile all Jerusalem and all the princes and all the valiant, mighty men, ten thousand he was taking into exile, and also every craftsman and builder of bulwarks. No one had been left behind except the lowly class of the people of the land. (2 Kings 24:14)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Like these good figs, so I shall regard the exiles of Judah, whom I will send away from this place to the land of the Chaldeans, in a good way.

- Be in severe pains and burst forth, O daughter of Zion, like a woman giving birth, for now you will go forth from a town, and you will have to reside in the field. - Send to all the exiled people, saying; This is what Yehowah has said concerning Shemaiah of Nehelam; For the reason that Shemaiah has prophesied to You people, but I myself did not send him, and he tried to make You trust in falsehood. (Jeremiah 29:31)
