

**Jeremiah 29:21**· **This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said concerning Ahab the son of Kolaiah and to Zedekiah the son of Maaseiah, who are prophesying to you falsehood in my own name; Here I am giving them into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, and he must strike them down before your eyes.**

- And **Yehowah** went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are **prophesying** in my **name**. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to **you** people. (**Jeremiah 14:14**)
- For this is what **Yehowah** of **armies**, the **God** of **Israel**, **has said**; Let not **your** prophets who are in among **you** and **your** practicers of divination deceive **you**, and do not **you** listen to their dreams that they are dreaming. (**Jeremiah 29:8**)
- Your **own** prophets have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things; And they have not uncovered your error in order to turn back your captivity; But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (**Lamentations 2:14**)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
- And these the **king** of **Babylon** proceeded to **strike down** and to put them to death in Riblah in the land of Hamath. Thus Judah went into exile from off its soil. (**Jeremiah 52:27**)
- Then **Zedekiah** the **son** of Chenaanah made for himself horns of iron and **said**; This is what **Yehowah** **has said**; With these you will push the Syrians until you exterminate them. (**2 Chronicles 18:10**)
- For this is what **Yehowah** **has said**; **Here I am** making you a fright to yourself and to all your lovers, and they will certainly fall by the sword of their enemies while your **eyes** will be looking on, and all Judah I shall give into the **hand** of the **king** of **Babylon**,

- and he will actually take them into exile in **Babylon** and **strike** them **down** with the sword. (**Jeremiah 20:4**)
- And as for you, O Pashhur, and all the inhabitants of your house, **you** will go into captivity, and to **Babylon** you will come and there you will die and there you yourself will be buried with all your lovers, because you have prophesied to them in **falsehood**. (**Jeremiah 20:6**)
  - For I have not sent them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, but they are **prophesying** in my **name** falsely, to the end that I shall disperse **you**, and **you** will have to perish, **you** men and the prophets that are **prophesying** to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:15**)
  - For the teraphim themselves have spoken what is uncanny, and the practicers of divination, for their part, have visioned **falsehood**, and valueless dreams are what they keep speaking, and in vain they try to comfort. That is why they will certainly depart like a flock, they will become afflicted, because there is no shepherd. (**Zechariah 10:2**)
