- Accordingly she wrote **letters** in Ahab's **name** and sealed them with his seal, and **sent** the **letters** to the older men and the nobles that were in his city dwelling with Naboth. (**1 Kings 21:8**)
- Even **letters** he wrote to reproach **Yehowah** the **God** of **Israel** and to talk against him, **saying**; Like the gods of the nations of the lands who did not deliver their **people** out of my hand, so the **God** of Hezekiah will not deliver his **people** out of my hand. (**2 Chronicles 32:17**)
- Finally Sanballat **sent** his attendant to me with the same word a fifth time, with an open letter in his hand. (**Nehemiah 6:5**)
- Furthermore, the chief of the bodyguard took Seraiah the chief **priest** and **Zephaniah** the second **priest** and three doorkeepers. (**2 Kings 25:18**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from **Yehowah**, when King Zedekiah **sent** to him Pashhur the **son** of Malchiah and **Zephaniah** the **son** of **Maaseiah**, the **priest**, **saying**; (**Jeremiah 21:1**)
- And **Zephaniah** the **priest** proceeded to read this letter in the ears of Jeremiah the prophet. (**Jeremiah 29:29**)
- And King Zedekiah proceeded to send Jehucal the **son** of Shelemiah and **Zephaniah** the **son** of **Maaseiah** the **priest** to Jeremiah the prophet, **saying**; Pray, please, in our behalf to **Yehowah** our God. (**Jeremiah 37:3**)
- Furthermore, the chief of the bodyguard took Seraiah the chief **priest** and **Zephaniah** the second **priest** and the three doorkeepers. (**Jeremiah 52:24**)
