Jeremiah 29:31. Send to all the exiled people, saying; This is what Yehowah has said concerning Shemaiah of Nehelam; For the reason that Shemaiah has prophesied to you people, but I myself did not send him, and he tried to make you trust in falsehood.

- And he took into exile all Jerusalem and all the princes and all the valiant, mighty men, ten thousand he was taking into exile, and also every craftsman and builder of bulwarks. No one had been left behind except the lowly class of the people of the land. (2 Kings 24:14)
- And as for you, hear the word of Yehowah, all you exiled people, whom I have sent away from Jerusalem to Babylon. (Jeremiah 29:20)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- I did not send the prophets, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (Jeremiah 23:21)
- And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah has not sent you, but you yourself have caused this people to trust in a falsehood. (Jeremiah 28:15)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that you men have spoken untruth and you have visioned a lie, therefore here I am against you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 13:8)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among You. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (2 Peter 2:1)
- At this he said to him; I too am a prophet like you, and an angel himself spoke to me by the word of Yehowah, saying, Have him

- come back with you to your house that he may eat bread and drink water. He deceived him. (1 Kings 13:18)
- And to Shemaiah of Nehelam you will say. (Jeremiah 29:24)
- They have visioned what is untrue and a lying divination, those who are saying; The utterance of Yehowah is, when Yehowah himself has not sent them, and they have waited to have a word come true. (Ezekiel 13:6)
