Jeremiah 29:8. For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Let not your prophets who are in among you and your practicers of divination deceive you, and do not you listen to their dreams that they are dreaming.

- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- I did not send the prophets, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (Jeremiah 23:21)
- And do not listen to the words of the prophets that are saying to you men, you will not serve the king of Babylon, because falsehood is what they are prophesying to you. (Jeremiah 27:14)
- Let no man deceive You with empty words, for because of the aforesaid things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. (Ephesians 5:6)
- You must not listen to the words of that prophet or to the dreamer of that dream, because Yehowah Your God is testing You to know whether You are loving Yehowah Your God with all Your heart and all Your soul. (Deuteronomy 13:3)
- And as for you men, do not listen to Your prophets and to Your practicers of divination and to Your dreamers and to Your practicers of magic and to Your sorcerers, who are saying to You; You men will not serve the king of Babylon. (Jeremiah 27:9)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said concerning Ahab the son of Kolaiah and to Zedekiah the son of Maaseiah, who are prophesying to you falsehood in my own name; Here I am giving them into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, and he must strike them down before your eyes. (Jeremiah 29:21)
