Jeremiah 2:19. Your badness should correct you, and your own acts of unfaithfulness should reprove you. Know, then, and see that your leaving Yehowah your God is something bad and bitter, and no dread of me has resulted to you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies.

[15] - References:

- The very expression of their faces actually testifies against them, and of their sin like that of Sodom they do tell. They have not hidden it. Woe to their soul! For they have dealt out to themselves calamity. (Isaiah 3:9)
- And the pride of Israel has testified to his face, and Israel and Ephraim themselves are made to stumble in their error. Judah has also stumbled with them. (Hosea 5:5)
- And my people are tending toward unfaithfulness to me. And upward they call it, no one at all does any rising up. (Hosea 11:7)
- Your way and your dealings, there will be a rendering of these to you. This is the calamity upon you, for it is bitter, because it has reached clear to your heart. (Jeremiah 4:18)
- And I will turn Your festivals into mourning and all Your songs into a dirge, and I will bring up upon all hips sackcloth and upon every head baldness, and I will make the situation like the mourning for an only son, and the end result of it as a bitter day. (Amos 8:10)
- Do you not fear even me, is the utterance of Yehowah, or are you in no severe pains even because of me, who have set the sand as the boundary for the sea, an indefinitely lasting regulation that it cannot pass over? Although its waves toss themselves, still they cannot prevail, and although they do become boisterous, still they cannot pass over it. (Jeremiah 5:22)
- Upon hearing this they with one accord raised their voices to God and said; Sovereign Lord, you are the One who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and all the things in them. (Acts of Apostles 4:24)
- O that they were wise! Then they would ponder over this. They would consider their end afterward. (Deuteronomy 32:29)

- And God's spirit itself enveloped Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, so that he stood up above the people and said to them; This is what the true God has said, Why are you overstepping the commandments of Yehowah, so that you cannot prove successful? Because you have left Yehowah, he will, in turn, leave you. (2 Chronicles 24:20)
- Accordingly Pekah the son of Remaliah killed in Judah a hundred and twenty thousand in one day, all valiant men, because of their leaving Yehowah the God of their forefathers. (2 Chronicles 28:6)
- Those who were foolish, due to the way of their transgression and due to their errors, finally caused themselves affliction. (Psalms 107:17)
- We lie down in our shame, and our humiliation keeps covering us, for it is toward Yehowah our God that we have sinned, we and our fathers from our youth on and down to this day, and we have not obeyed the voice of Yehowah our God. (Jeremiah 3:25)
- For my people have forgotten me in that they make sacrificial smoke to something worthless, and in that they make men stumble in their ways, the paths of long ago, to walk in roadways, a way not banked up. (Jeremiah 18:15)
- Do come back, O Israel, to Yehowah your God, for you have stumbled in your error. (Hosea 14:1)
- And said; This man said, I am able to throw down the temple of God and build it up in three days. (Matthew 26:61)
