Jeremiah 2:26... As with the shame of a thief when he is found out, so those of the house of Israel have felt shame, they, their kings, their princes and their priests and their prophets.

- In case a man should give his fellow money or articles to keep, and it gets stolen from the man's house, if the thief should be found, he is to make double compensation. (Exodus 22:7)
- From the days of our forefathers we have been in great guiltiness until this day, and because of our errors we have been given, we ourselves, our kings, our priests, into the hand of the kings of the lands with the sword, with the captivity and with the plunder and with shame of face, just as this day. (Ezra 9:7)
- And we have not listened to your servants the prophets, who have spoken in your name to our kings, our princes and our forefathers and to all the people of the land. (Daniel 9:6)
- If a thief should be found in the act of breaking in and he does get struck and die, there is no bloodguilt for him. (Exodus 22:2)
- Finally he had his household come near, able-bodied man by able-bodied man, and Achan the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, got to be picked. (Joshua 7:18)
- And now, O our God, the God great, mighty and fear-inspiring, keeping the covenant and loving-kindness, do not let all the hardship that has found us, our kings, our princes and our priests and our prophets and our forefathers and all your people from the days of the kings of Assyria down to this day, seem little before you. (Nehemiah 9:32)
- They must be turned back, they will be very much ashamed, those who are putting trust in the carved image, those who are saying to a molten image; You are our gods. (Isaiah 42:17)
- We lie down in our shame, and our humiliation keeps covering us, for it is toward Yehowah our God that we have sinned, we and our fathers from our youth on and down to this day, and we have not obeyed the voice of Yehowah our God. (Jeremiah 3:25)

- A wind will shepherd all your own shepherds, and as for those intensely loving you, they will go into captivity itself. For at that time you will be ashamed and certainly feel humiliated because of all your calamity. (Jeremiah 22:22)
- And did not Israel become a mere object of ridicule to you? Or was he found among outright thieves? For you would shake yourself just as often as you spoke against him. (Jeremiah 48:27)
- In order that you may bear your humiliation, and you must feel humiliated owing to all that you have done, in that you comforted them. (Ezekiel 16:54)
- To you, O Yehowah, there belongs the righteousness, but to us the shame of face as at this day, to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to all those of Israel, those nearby and those far away in all the lands to which you dispersed them because of their unfaithfulness with which they acted against you. (Daniel 9:7)
- For their mother has committed fornication. She that was pregnant with them has acted shamefully, for she has said, I want to go after those passionately loving me, those giving my bread and my water, my wool and my linen, my oil and my drink. (Hosea 2:5)
- A wind has wrapped her up in its wings. And they will be ashamed of their sacrifices. (Hosea 4:19)
- Even it someone will bring to Assyria itself as a gift to a great king. Shame is what Ephraim himself will get, and Israel will be ashamed of its counsel. (Hosea 10:6)
- And it must occur in that day that the prophets will become ashamed, each one of his vision when he prophesies, and they will not wear an official garment of hair for the purpose of deceiving. (Zechariah 13:4)
