

Jeremiah 2:30 To no effect I have struck YOUR sons. No discipline did they take. YOUR sword has devoured YOUR prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin.**

- However, at the time that he was **causing** him distress, he acted unfaithfully still more toward Yehowah, that is, King Ahaz did. (**2 Chronicles 28:22**)
- And the people themselves **have** not returned to the One striking them, and Yehowah of armies they **have** not sought. (**Isaiah 9:13**)
- Where else will **you** be **struck** still more, in that **you** add more revolt? The whole head is in a sick condition, and the whole heart is feeble. (**Isaiah 1:5**)
- O Yehowah, are not those eyes of yours toward faithfulness? You **have struck** them, but they did not become ill. You exterminated them. They refused to **take discipline**. They made their faces harder than a crag. They refused to turn back. (**Jeremiah 5:3**)
- She did not listen to a voice, she did not accept **discipline**. In Yehowah she did not trust. To her God she did not draw near. (**Zephaniah 3:2**)
- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his **prophets**, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (**2 Chronicles 36:16**)
- However, they became disobedient and rebelled against you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your own **prophets** they killed, who bore witness against them to bring them back to you, and they went on committing acts of great disrespect. (**Nehemiah 9:26**)
- However, the cultivators took his slaves, and one they beat up, another they killed, another they stoned. (**Matthew 21:35**)
- For this reason, here I am sending forth to **you prophets** and wise men and public instructors. Some of them **you** will kill and

- impale, and some of them **you** will scourge in **YOUR** synagogues and persecute from city to city. (**Matthew 23:34**)
- Which one of the **prophets** did **YOUR** forefathers not persecute? Yes, they killed those who made announcement in advance concerning the coming of the righteous One, whose betrayers and murderers **you have** now become. (**Acts of Apostles 7:52**)
 - Who killed even the Lord Jesus and the **prophets** and persecuted us. Furthermore, they are not pleasing God, but are against the interests of all men. (**1 Thessalonians 2:15**)
 - Nevertheless, if with these things **you** do not let yourselves be corrected by me and **you** just **have** to walk in opposition to me. (**Leviticus 26:23**)
 - And the **sons** of Benjamin went collecting together behind Abner, and they came to be one company and kept standing upon the top of one hill. (**2 Samuel 2:25**)
 - At that David said to the messenger; This is what you will say to Joab, Do not let this matter appear bad in your eyes, for the **sword** eats up one as well as another. Intensify your battle against the city and throw it down. And encourage him. (**2 Samuel 11:25**)
 - And they proceeded to bring Urijah out from Egypt and to bring him to King Jehoiakim, who then **struck** him down with the **sword** and cast his dead body into the graveyard of the **sons** of the people. (**Jeremiah 26:23**)
 - Tell it in Egypt, O men, and publish it in Migdol, and publish it in Noph and in Tahpanhes. Say, Station yourself, making preparation also for yourself, for a **sword** will certainly devour all around you. (**Jeremiah 46:14**)
 - Just as it is written in the Law of Moses, all this calamity, it **has** come upon us, and we **have** not softened the face of Yehowah our God by turning back from our error and by showing insight into your trueness. (**Daniel 9:13**)
 - Listen! The howling of shepherds, for their majesty **has** been despoiled. Listen! The roaring of maned young **lions**, for the proud thickets along the Jordan **have** been despoiled. (**Zechariah 11:3**)
