

Jeremiah 2:31 • **O generation, see for yourselves the word of Yehowah. Have I become a mere wilderness to Israel or a land of intense darkness? Why is it that these, my people, have said; We have roamed. We shall come to you no more?**

[5] - References:

- To the city the very voice of **Yehowah** calls out, and the person of practical wisdom will fear your name. Hear the rod and who it was that designated it, O **you people**. (**Micah 6:9**)
- Then Azariah the chief priest of the house of Zadok **said** to him, yes, he **said**; From the time they started to bring the contribution into the house of **Yehowah** there has been an eating and getting satisfied and having a surplus in abundance, for **Yehowah** himself has blessed his **people**, and what has been left over is this great plenty. (**2 Chronicles 31:10**)
- And they went capturing fortified cities and a fat soil and taking in possession houses full of all good things, cisterns hewn out, vineyards and olive groves and trees for food in abundance, and they began to eat and to be satisfied and to grow fat and to luxuriate in your great goodness. (**Nehemiah 9:25**)
- When Jeshurun began to grow fat, then he kicked. You **have** grown fat, you **have become** thick, you **have become** gorged. So he forsook God, who made him, and despised the Rock of his salvation. (**Deuteronomy 32:15**)
- I spoke to you during your freedom from care. You **said**; I shall not obey. This has been your way since your youth, for you did not obey my voice. (**Jeremiah 22:21**)
