- And Yehowah has a legal case with Judah, even to hold an accounting against Jacob according to his **ways**, according to his dealings he **will** repay him. (**Hosea 12:2**)
- And the stronghold of Pharaoh must **become** even for **you** men a reason for shame, and the refuge in the shadow of **Egypt** a cause for humiliation. (**Isaiah 30:3**)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; This is what **you** men should say to the king of Judah, the one sending **you** to me to inquire of me; Look! The military force of Pharaoh that is coming forth to **you** people for the purpose of assistance **will** have to go back to their land, **Egypt**. (**Jeremiah 37:7**)
- Eventually Tilgath-pilneser the king of **Assyria** came against him and caused him distress, and did not strengthen him. (**2 Chronicles 28:20**)
- Every one **will** certainly **become ashamed** of a people that bring no benefit to one, that are of no help and bring no benefit, but are a reason for shame and also a cause for reproach. (**Isaiah 30:5**)
- But the burden of Yehowah mention no more **you** people, for the burden itself **becomes** to each one his own word, and **you** have changed the words of the living God, Yehowah of armies, our God. (**Jeremiah 23:36**)
- To **Egypt** we have given the hand, to **Assyria**, in order to get satisfaction with bread. (**Lamentations 5:6**)
- And you went prostituting yourself to the sons of **Egypt**, your neighbors great of flesh, and you continued making your prostitution abound in order to offend me. (**Ezekiel 16:26**)
