Jeremiah 2:5. This is what Yehowah has said; What have your fathers found in me that was unjust, so that they have become far off from me, and they kept walking after the vain idol and becoming vain themselves?

[17] - References:

- What is there yet to do for my vineyard that I have not already done in it? Why is it that I hoped for it to produce grapes, but it gradually produced wild grapes? (Isaiah 5:4)
- O my people, what have I done to you? And in what way have I tired you out? Testify against me. (Micah 6:3)
- You have planted them, they have also taken root. They keep going ahead, they have also produced fruit. You are near in their mouth, but far away from their kidneys. (Jeremiah 12:2)
- They, for their part, have incited me to jealousy with what is no god, They have vexed me with their vain idols, And I, for my part, shall incite them to jealousy with what is no people, With a stupid nation I shall offend them. (Deuteronomy 32:21)
- And he went walking in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat and in his sin with which he caused Israel to sin by offending Yehowah the God of Israel with their vain idols. (1 Kings 16:26)
- And they continued rejecting his regulations and his covenant that he had concluded with their forefathers and his reminders with which he had warned them, and they went following vain idols and became vain themselves, even in imitation of the nations that were all around them, concerning whom Yehowah had commanded them not to do like them. (2 Kings 17:15)
- And saying; Men, why are you doing these things? We also are humans having the same infirmities as you do, and are declaring the Good News to you, for you to turn from these vain things to the living God, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and all the things in them. (Acts of Apostles 14:15)
- Those making them will become just like them, all those who are trusting in them. (Psalms 115:8)

- And you must not turn aside to follow the unrealities that are of no benefit and that do not deliver, because they are unrealities. (1 Samuel 12:21)
- Consequently Yehowah's anger became hot against Amaziah, and so he sent a prophet to him and said to him; Why have you searched for the people's gods that did not deliver their own people out of your hand? (2 Chronicles 25:15)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (Isaiah 1:4)
- Come, now, you people, and let us set matters straight between us, says Yehowah. Though the sins of you people should prove to be as scarlet, they will be made white just like snow, though they should be red like crimson cloth, they will become even like wool. (Isaiah 1:18)
- And now, O you inhabitants of Jerusalem and you men of Judah, please judge between me and my vineyard. (Isaiah 5:3)
- Listen to me, you the ones powerful at heart, you the ones far away from righteousness. (Isaiah 46:12)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the words of the prophets who are prophesying to you people. They are making you become vain. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:16)
- For the purpose of catching the house of Israel by their heart, because they have withdrawn themselves from me through their dungy idols, all of them. (Ezekiel 14:5)
- Woe to them, for they have fled from me! Despoiling to them, for they have transgressed against me! And I myself proceeded to redeem them, but they themselves have spoken lies even against me. (Hosea 7:13)
