

**Jeremiah 2:5**• **This is what Yehowah has said; What have YOUR fathers found in me that was unjust, so that they have become far off from me, and they kept walking after the vain idol and becoming vain themselves?**

[17] - References:

- What is there yet to do for my vineyard that I **have** not already done in it? Why is it that I hoped for it to produce grapes, but it gradually produced wild grapes? (**Isaiah 5:4**)
- O my people, what **have** I done to you? And in what way **have** I tired you out? Testify against me. (**Micah 6:3**)
- You **have** planted them, they **have** also taken root. They keep going ahead, they **have** also produced fruit. You are near in their mouth, but **far** away from their kidneys. (**Jeremiah 12:2**)
- They, for their part, **have** incited me to jealousy with what is no god, They **have** vexed me with their **vain idols**, And I, for my part, shall incite them to jealousy with what is no people, With a stupid nation I shall offend them. (**Deuteronomy 32:21**)
- And he went **walking** in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat and in his sin with which he caused Israel to sin by offending **Yehowah** the God of Israel with their **vain idols**. (**1 Kings 16:26**)
- And they continued rejecting his regulations and his covenant that he had concluded with their forefathers and his reminders with which he had warned them, and they went following **vain idols** and became **vain** themselves, even in imitation of the nations that were all around them, concerning whom **Yehowah** had commanded them not to do like them. (**2 Kings 17:15**)
- And saying; Men, why are **you** doing these things? We also are humans having the same infirmities as **you** do, and are declaring the Good News to **you**, for **you** to turn from these **vain** things to the living God, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and all the things in them. (**Acts of Apostles 14:15**)
- Those making them will **become** just like them, all those who are trusting in them. (**Psalms 115:8**)

- And **you** must not turn aside to follow the unrealities that are of no benefit and that do not deliver, because they are unrealities. (**1 Samuel 12:21**)
- Consequently Yehowah's anger became hot against Amaziah, and so he sent a prophet to him and **said** to him; Why **have** you searched for the people's gods that did not deliver their own people out of your hand? (**2 Chronicles 25:15**)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They **have** left Yehowah, they **have** treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they **have** turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- Come, now, **you** people, and let us set matters straight between us, says Yehowah. Though the sins of **you** people should prove to be as scarlet, they will be made white just like snow, though they should be red like crimson cloth, they will **become** even like wool. (**Isaiah 1:18**)
- And now, O **you** inhabitants of Jerusalem and **you** men of Judah, please judge between me and my vineyard. (**Isaiah 5:3**)
- Listen to me, **you** the ones powerful at heart, **you** the ones **far** away from righteousness. (**Isaiah 46:12**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies **has said**; Do not listen to the words of the prophets who are prophesying to **you** people. They are making **you** **become vain**. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:16**)
- For the purpose of catching the house of Israel by their heart, because they **have** withdrawn themselves from me through their dungy idols, all of them. (**Ezekiel 14:5**)
- Woe to them, for they **have** fled from me! Despoiling to them, for they **have** transgressed against me! And I myself proceeded to redeem them, but they themselves **have** spoken lies even against me. (**Hosea 7:13**)
