Jeremiah 30:10. And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah, and do not be struck with terror, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far off and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and be free of disturbance and be at ease, and there will be no one causing trembling.

- For I, Yehowah your God, am grasping your right hand, the One saying to you, Do not be afraid. I myself will help you. (Isaiah 41:13)
- Do not be afraid, for I am with you. From the sunrising I shall bring your seed, and from the sunset I shall collect you together. (Isaiah 43:5)
- This is what Yehowah has said, your Maker and your Former, who kept helping you even from the belly, Do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and you, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. (Isaiah 44:2)
- But this is what Yehowah has said; Even the body of captives of the mighty man will be taken away, and those already taken by the tyrant himself will make their escape. And against anyone contending against you I myself shall contend, and your own sons I myself shall save. (Isaiah 49:25)
- In those days they will walk, the house of Judah alongside the house of Israel, and together they will come out of the land of the north into the land that I gave as a hereditary possession to YOUR forefathers. (Jeremiah 3:18)
- In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem itself will reside in security. And this is what she will be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (Jeremiah 33:16)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (Jeremiah 46:27)
- And I will conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall certainly cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the land,

- and they will actually dwell in the wilderness in security and sleep in the forests. (Ezekiel 34:25)
- And for them I shall certainly conclude a covenant in that day in connection with the wild beast of the field and with the flying creature of the heavens and the creeping thing of the ground, and the bow and the sword and war I shall break out of the land, and I will make them lie down in security. (Hosea 2:18)
- And they will actually sit, each one under his vine and under his fig tree, and there will be no one making them tremble, for the very mouth of Yehowah of armies has spoken it. (Micah 4:4)
- And I will put peace in the land, and you will indeed lie down, with no one making you tremble, and I will make the injurious wild beast cease out of the land, and a sword will not pass through your land. (Leviticus 26:6)
- And it must occur in the day when Yehowah gives you rest from your pain and from your agitation and from the hard slavery in which you were made a slave. (Isaiah 14:3)
- And now listen, O Jacob my servant, and you, O Israel, whom I have chosen. (Isaiah 44:1)
- As for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah, for I am with you. For I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have dispersed you, but with you I shall make no extermination. Yet I shall have to chastise you to the proper degree, and I shall absolutely not leave you unpunished. (Jeremiah 46:28)
- And when it occurs I will let you have as a remnant the ones escaping from the sword among the nations, when you get scattered among the lands. (Ezekiel 6:8)
- Therefore say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I will also collect you from the peoples and gather you from the lands among which you have been scattered, and I will give you the soil of Israel. (Ezekiel 11:17)
- And they will no longer become something to plunder for the nations, and as regards the wild beast of the earth, it will not devour them, and they will actually dwell in security, with no one to make them tremble. (Ezekiel 34:28)

- When I bring them back from the peoples and I actually collect them together out of the lands of their enemies, I will also sanctify myself among them before the eyes of many nations. (Ezekiel 39:27)
- And I will gather back the captive ones of my people Israel, and they will actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (Amos 9:14)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they will feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they will lie stretched out. For Yehowah their God will turn his attention to them and certainly gather back the captive ones of them. (Zephaniah 2:7)
- As regards the remaining ones of Israel, they will do no unrighteousness, nor speak a lie, nor will there be found in their mouths a tricky tongue, for they themselves will feed and actually lie stretched out, and there will be no one making them tremble. (Zephaniah 3:13)
- At that time I shall bring you people in, even in the time of my collecting you together. For I shall make you people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather back your captive ones before your eyes, Yehowah has said. (Zephaniah 3:20)
- And Yehowah proceeded to answer the angel who was speaking with me, with good words, comforting words. (Zechariah 1:13)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; There will yet sit old men and old women in the public squares of Jerusalem, each one also with his staff in his hand because of the abundance of his days. (Zechariah 8:4)
