Jeremiah 30:2... This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Write for yourself in a book all the words that I will speak to you.

- Take for yourself a roll of a book, and you must write in it all the words that I have spoken to you against Israel and against Judah and against all the nations, since the day that I spoke to you, since the days of Josiah, clear down to this day. (Jeremiah 36:2)
- And Jeremiah proceeded to write in one book all the calamity that would come upon Babylon, even all these words written against Babylon. (Jeremiah 51:60)
- In the first year of Belshazzar the king of Babylon, Daniel himself beheld a dream and visions of his head upon his bed. At that time he wrote down the dream itself. The complete account of the matters he told. (Daniel 7:1)
- And Yehowah proceeded to answer me and to say; Write down the vision, and set it out plainly upon tablets, in order that the one reading aloud from it may do so fluently. (Habakkuk 2:2)
- For all the things that were written aforetime were written for our instruction, that through our endurance and through the comfort from the Scriptures we might have hope. (Romans 15:4)
