Jeremiah 30:7" Alas! For that day is a great one, so that there is no other like it, and it is the time of distress for Jacob. But he will be saved even out of it.

And during that time your people will escape, every one who is found written down in the book. (Daniel 12:1)
- For then there will be great tribulation such as has not occurred since the world's beginning until now, no, nor will occur again. (Matthew 24:21)
- And Yehowah has a legal case with Judah, even to hold an accounting against Jacob according to his dealings he will repay him. (Hosea 12:2)
- Is there no balsam in Gilead? Or is there no healer there? Why is it, then, that the recuperation of the daughter of my people has not come up? (Jeremiah 8:22)

- Alas for the day, because the day of Yehowah is near, and like a despoiling from the Almighty One it will come! (Joel 1:15)
- And you ought not to stand at the parting of the ways, in order to cut off his escapees, and you ought not to hand over his survivors in the day of distress. (Obadiah 1:14)
