[11] - References:

- Incline **YOUR** ear and come to me. Listen, and **YOUR** soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with **YOU** people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to **David** that are faithful. (**Isaiah 55:3**)
- And I will **raise** up over them one shepherd, and he must feed them, even my servant **David**. He himself will feed them, and he himself will become their shepherd. (**Ezekiel 34:23**)
- Afterwards the sons of Israel will come back and **certainly** look for **Yehowah** their **God**, and for **David** their **king**, and they will **certainly** come quivering to **Yehowah** and to his goodness in the final part of the days. (**Hosea 3:5**)
- And my servant **David** will be **king** over them, and one shepherd is what they will all come to have, and in my judicial decisions they will walk, and my statutes they will keep, and they will **certainly** carry them out. (**Ezekiel 37:24**)
- And he has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of **David** his servant. (**Luke 1:69**)
- Therefore, because he was a prophet and knew that **God** had sworn to him with an oath that he would seat one from the fruitage of his loins upon his throne. (**Acts of Apostles 2:30**)
- From the offspring of this man according to his promise **God** has brought to Israel a savior, Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 13:23**)
- I have concluded a covenant toward my chosen one, I have sworn to **David** my servant. (**Psalms 89:3**)
- And I shall **certainly** defend this city to save it for my own sake and for the sake of **David** my servant. (**Isaiah 37:35**)
- Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (**Isaiah 55:4**)
