- Hence the people were not distinguishing the sound of the shout of rejoicing from the sound of the weeping of the people, for the people were shouting with a loud shout, and the sound itself was heard even to a great distance. (**Ezra 3:13**)
- When Yehowah gathered back the captive ones of Zion, we became like those who were dreaming. (**Psalms 126:1**)
- Then the redeemed ones of Yehowah themselves will return and must come to Zion with a joyful outcry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain. Grief and sighing will certainly flee away. (**Isaiah 51:11**)
- For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, there is where they, the whole house of Israel in its entirety, will serve me, in the land. There I shall take pleasure in them, and there I shall require YOUR contributions and the firstfruits of YOUR presentations in all YOUR holy things. (**Ezekiel 20:40**)
- They looked to him and became radiant, and their very faces could not possibly be ashamed. (**Psalms 34:5**)
- At that time you will see and certainly become radiant, and your heart will actually quiver and expand, because to you the wealthiness of the sea will direct itself, the very resources of the nations will come to you. (**Isaiah 60:5**)
- And it must occur in that day that the mountains will drip with sweet wine, and the very hills will flow with milk, and the very streambeds of Judah will all flow with water. And out of the house of Yehowah there will go forth a spring, and it must irrigate the torrent valley of the Acacia Trees. (**Joel 3:18**)

- **Yehowah** of armies himself **will** defend them, and they **will** actually devour and subdue the slingstones. And they **will** **certainly** drink, be boisterous, as if there were **wine**, and they **will** actually **become** filled like the bowl, like the corners of the altar. (**Zechariah 9:15**)
- And Sharon must **become** a pasture ground for sheep and the low plain of Achor a resting-place for **cattle**, for my people who **will** have looked for me. (**Isaiah 65:10**)
- And **Yehowah** **will** be bound to lead you constantly and to satisfy your **soul** even in a scorched land, and he **will** invigorate your very bones, and you must **become** like a **well-watered garden**, and like the source of water, the waters of which do not lie. (**Isaiah 58:11**)
- And the very **ones** redeemed by **Yehowah** **will** return and **certainly come** to **Zion** with a joyful **cry**, and rejoicing to time indefinite **will** be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they **will** attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
- I saw also the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down **out** of heaven from God and prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (**Revelation 21:2**)
- Like torrent valleys they have extended a long way, like **gardens** by the river. Like aloe plants that **Yehowah** has planted, like cedars by the waters. (**Numbers 24:6**)
- On the eighth day he sent the people away, and they began to bless the king and to go to their homes, rejoicing and feeling merry of heart over all the **goodness** that **Yehowah** had performed for David his servant and for Israel his people. (**1 Kings 8:66**)
- You yourself **will** arise, you **will** have mercy on **Zion**, for it is the season to be favorable to her, for the appointed time has **come**. (**Psalms 102:13**)
- At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful **cry**. At that time they proceeded to say among the nations; Yehowah has done a great thing in what he has done with them. (**Psalms 126:2**)

- With the mention of the abundance of your **goodness** they **will** bubble over, and because of your righteousness they **will cry out joyfully**. (**Psalms 145:7**)
- Come, feed yourselves with my bread and share in drinking the **wine** that I have mixed. (**Proverbs 9:5**)
- There is a hard vision that has been told to me; The treacherous dealer is dealing treacherously, and the despoiler is despoiling. Go up, O Elam! Lay siege, O Media! All sighing due to her I have caused to cease. (**Isaiah 21:2**)
- They themselves **will** raise their voice, they **will cry out joyfully**. In the superiority of **Yehowah** they **will certainly cry out** shrilly from the sea. (**Isaiah 24:14**)
- And **Yehowah** of armies **will certainly** make for all the peoples, in this mountain, a banquet of well-oiled dishes, a banquet of **wine** kept on the dregs, of well-oiled dishes filled with marrow, of **wine** kept on the dregs, filtered. (**Isaiah 25:6**)
- For **Yehowah will certainly** comfort **Zion**. He **will** for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he **will** make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the **garden** of **Yehowah**. Exultation and rejoicing themselves **will** be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody. (**Isaiah 51:3**)
- And I **will** be joyful in Jerusalem and exult in my people, and no more **will** there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (**Isaiah 65:19**)
- And I **will** exult over them to do them good, and I **will** plant them in this land in trueness with all my heart and with all my **soul**. (**Jeremiah 32:41**)
- The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; **LAUD Yehowah** of armies, for **Yehowah** is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness! They **will** be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of **Yehowah**, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, **Yehowah** has said. (**Jeremiah 33:11**)
- In a good pasturage I shall feed them, and on Israel's high mountains their abiding place **will come** to be. There they **will** lie

down in a good abiding place, and on a fat pasturage they **will** feed upon the mountains of Israel. (**Ezekiel 34:14**)

- This is what **Yehowah** of armies has said; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth month, and the fast of the seventh month, and the fast of the tenth month **will become** for the house of Judah an exultation and a rejoicing and good festal seasons. So love truth and peace. (**Zechariah 8:19**)
