Jeremiah 31:14" And I will saturate the soul of the priests with fatness, and with my goodness my own people will become satisfied, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- They drink their fill of the fatness of your house, and of the torrent of your pleasures you cause them to drink. (Psalms 36:8)
- And Yehowah your God will indeed make you have more than enough in every work of your hand, in the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your soil, resulting in prosperity, because Yehowah will again exult over you for good, just as he exulted over your forefathers.

- How abundant your goodness is, which you have treasured up for those fearing you! Which you have rendered to those taking refuge in you, in front of the sons of men. (Psalms 31:19)
- The loving-kindnesses of Yehowah I shall mention, the praises of Yehowah, according to all that Yehowah has rendered to us, even the abundant goodness to the house of Israel that he has rendered to them according to his mercies and according to the abundance of his loving-kindnesses. - As with the best part, even fatness, my soul is satisfied, and with lips of joyful cries my mouth offers praise. (Psalms 63:5)
