- Because the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne, **will** shepherd them, and **will** guide them to fountains of waters of life. And God **will** wipe out every tear from their eyes. (**Revelation 7:17**)
- Then the heads of the fathers of Judah and of Benjamin and the priests and the Levites rose up, even everyone whose spirit the true God had roused, to go up and rebuild the house of **Yehowah**, which was in Jerusalem. (**Ezra 1:5**)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the **lands** to which I had dispersed them, and I **will** bring them **back** to their pasture ground, and they **will certainly** be fruitful and become many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)
