Jeremiah 31:18... I have positively heard Ephraim bemoaning himself, You have corrected me, that I may be corrected, like a calf that has not been trained. Cause me to turn back, and I shall readily turn back, for you are Yehowah my God.

- With weeping they will come, and with their entreaties for favor I shall bring them. I shall make them walk to torrent valleys of water, in a right way in which they will not be caused to stumble. For I have become to Israel a Father, and as for Ephraim, he is my firstborn. (Jeremiah 31:9)
- Happy is the able-bodied man whom you correct, O Yah, and whom you teach out of your own Law. (Psalms 94:12)
- A whip is for the horse, a bridle is for the ass, and the rod is for the back of stupid people. (Proverbs 26:3)
- Heal me, O Yehowah, and I shall be healed. Save me, and I will be saved, for you are my praise. (Jeremiah 17:14)
- Bring us back, O Yehowah, to yourself, and we shall readily come back. Bring new days for us as in the long ago. (Lamentations 5:21)
- For I am Yehowah your God, the Holy One of Israel your Savior. I have given Egypt as a ransom for you, Ethiopia and Seba in place of you. (Isaiah 43:3)
- Answer me, O Yehowah, answer me, that this people may know that you, Yehowah, are the true God and you yourself have turned their heart back. (1 Kings 18:37)
- Do not make yourselves like a horse or mule without understanding, whose spiritedness is to be curbed even by bridle or halter Before they will come near to you. (Psalms 32:9)
- I have considered my ways, that I may turn back my feet to your reminders. (Psalms 119:59)
- Return, you renegade sons. I shall heal your renegade condition. Here we are! We have come to you, for you, O Yehowah, are our God. (Jeremiah 3:22)

- And you will certainly remember there your ways and all your dealings by which you defiled yourselves, and you will actually feel a loathing at your own faces because of all your bad things that you did. (Ezekiel 20:43)
- And you will be bound to remember your bad ways and your dealings that were not good, and you will be bound to feel a loathing at your own person on account of your errors and on account of your detestable things. (Ezekiel 36:31)
- And she will actually chase after her passionate lovers, but she will not overtake them, and she will certainly look for them, but she will not find them. And she will have to say, I want to go and return to my husband, the first one, for I had it better at that time than now. (Hosea 2:7)
