Jeremiah 31:28... And it must occur that just as I had kept alert toward them to uproot and to pull down and to tear down and to destroy and to do damage, so I shall keep alert toward them to build up and to plant, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- Here I am keeping alert toward them for calamity and not for good, and all the men of Judah that are in the land of Egypt will certainly come to their finish by the sword and by the famine, until they cease to be. (Jeremiah 44:27)
- And Yehowah kept alert to the calamity and finally brought it upon us, for Yehowah our God is righteous in all his works that he has done, and we have not obeyed his voice. (Daniel 9:14)
- At any moment that I may speak against a nation and against a kingdom to uproot it and to pull it down and to destroy it.

- This is what you should say to him; This is what Yehowah has said; Look! What I have built up I am tearing down, and what I have planted I am uprooting, even all the land itself. (Jeremiah 45:4)
- For Yehowah will certainly build up Zion, he must appear in his glory. (Psalms 102:16)
- Yehowah is building Jerusalem, the dispersed ones of Israel he brings together. (Psalms 147:2)
- And I will set my eye upon them in a good way, and I shall certainly cause them to return to this land. And I will build them up, and I shall not tear down, and I will plant them, and I shall not uproot. (Jeremiah 24:6)
- And I will exult over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land in trueness with all my heart and with all my soul.

 (Jeremiah 32:41)
- A time to kill and a time to heal, a time to break down and a time to build. (Ecclesiastes 3:3)
- For this is what Yehowah has said, Just as I have brought in upon this people all this great calamity, so I am bringing in upon them

all the goodness that I am speaking concerning them. (Jeremiah 32:42)

- 'If you will without fail keep dwelling in this land, I will also build you up and I shall not tear you down, and I will plant you and I shall not uproot you, for I shall certainly feel regret over the calamity that I have caused to you. (Jeremiah 42:10)
- But she was finally uprooted in fury. To the earth she was thrown, and there was an east wind that dried up her fruit. Her strong rod was torn off and became dry. Fire itself devoured it. (Ezekiel 19:12)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said, Just as I had in mind to do what was calamitous to you people because of your forefathers' making me indignant, Yehowah of armies has said, and I felt no regret. (Zechariah 8:14)
