- But it was because of Yehowah's loving **you**, and because of his keeping the sworn statement that he had sworn to **your** forefathers, that **Yehowah** brought **you** out with a strong hand, that he might redeem you from the house of slaves, from the hand of Pharaoh the king of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 7:8**)
- I **have loved** **you** people, **Yehowah** has said. And **you have** said; In what way **have** you **loved** us? Was not Esau the brother of Jacob? Is the utterance of **Yehowah**. But I **loved** Jacob. (**Malachi 1:2**)
- With the ropes of earthling man I kept drawing them, with the cords of **love**, so that I became to them as those lifting off a yoke on their jaws, and gently I brought food to each one. (**Hosea 11:4**)
- In order that, to quote him, they may believe that **Yehowah** the God of their forefathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob, has **appeared** to you. (**Exodus 4:5**)
- And **Yehowah** went passing by before his face and declaring; Yehowah, **Yehowah**, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in **loving-kindness** and truth. (**Exodus 34:6**)
- Give thanks to **Yehowah**, **you** people, for he is good, for to time **indefinite** is his **loving-kindness**. (**1 Chronicles 16:34**)
- And all the sons of Israel were spectators when the fire came down and the glory of **Yehowah** was upon the house, and they immediately bowed low with their faces to the earth upon the pavement and prostrated themselves and thanked **Yehowah**, for he is good, for his **loving-kindness** is to time indefinite. (**2 Chronicles 7:3**)
