- And now if **you** will strictly obey my voice and will indeed keep my **covenant**, then **you** will certainly become my special property **out** of all other peoples, because the whole earth belongs to me. (**Exodus 19:5**)
- And in the wilderness, where you saw how Yehowah your God carried you just as a man carries his son, in all the way that **you** walked until **your** coming to this place. (**Deuteronomy 1:31**)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I also must do with you just as you have done, because you despised the oath in breaking my **covenant**. (**Ezekiel 16:59**)
- Not according to the **covenant** that I made with their **forefathers** in the **day** of my **taking hold** of their **hand** to **bring** them forth **out** of the **land** of **Egypt**, because they did not continue in my **covenant**, so that I stopped caring for **them**, says **Yehowah**. (**Hebrews 8:9**)

- Then they will have to say; It was because they abandoned the **covenant** of Yehowah the God of their **forefathers**, which he **concluded** with them when he brought them **out** of the **land** of **Egypt**. (**Deuteronomy 29:25**)
- Yehowah now said to Moses; Look! You are lying down with your **forefathers**, and this people will certainly get up and have immoral intercourse with foreign gods of the **land** to which they

are going, in their very midst, and they will certainly forsake me and break my **covenant** that I have **concluded** with them. (**Deuteronomy 31:16**)

- There was nothing in the Ark but the two tablets that Moses had given at Horeb, when Yehowah covenanted with the sons of Israel while they were coming **out** from **Egypt**. (**2 Chronicles 5:10**)
- For the affair of the queen will go **out** to all the wives so that they will despise their owners in their own eyes, when they say, King Ahasuerus himself said to **bring** in Vashti the queen before him, and she did not come in. (**Esther 1:17**)
- They did not keep the **covenant** of God, and in his Law they refused to walk. (**Psalms 78:10**)

- And they will have to say; On account of the fact that they left the **covenant** of Yehowah their God and proceeded to bow down to other gods and to serve them. (**Jeremiah 22:9**)
