Jeremiah 31:32. Not one like the covenant that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, which covenant of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of Yehowah.

- And now if you will strictly obey my voice and will indeed keep my covenant, then you will certainly become my special property out of all other peoples, because the whole earth belongs to me. (Exodus 19:5)
- And in the wilderness, where you saw how Yehowah your God carried you just as a man carries his son, in all the way that you walked until YOUR coming to this place. (Deuteronomy 1:31)
