- And at the inauguration of the wall of Jerusalem they looked for the Levites, to bring them out of all their places to Jerusalem to carry on an inauguration and a rejoicing even with thanksgivings and with song, cymbals and stringed instruments and with harps. (**Nehemiah 12:27**)
- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he **will** completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be rebuilt. And of the temple: You **will** have your foundation laid. (**Isaiah 44:28**)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said; Here I am gathering the captive ones of the tents of Jacob, and for his tabernacles I shall have pity. And the **city will** actually be rebuilt upon her mound, and upon its rightful site the dwelling tower itself **will** sit. (**Jeremiah 30:18**)
- And Eliashib the High Priest and his brothers, the priests, proceeded to get up and build the Sheep **Gate**. They themselves sanctified it and went setting up its doors, and as far as the **Tower** of Meah they sanctified it, as far as the **Tower** of **Hananel**. (**Nehemiah 3:1**)
- And up over the **Gate** of Ephraim and on to the **Gate** of the Old City and clear to the Fish **Gate** and the **Tower** of **Hananel** and the **Tower** of Meah and on to the Sheep **Gate**, and they came to a stand at the **Gate** of the Guard. (**Nehemiah 12:39**)
- The whole land **will** be changed like the Arabah, from Geba to Rimmon to the south of Jerusalem, and she must rise and become inhabited in her place, from the **Gate** of Benjamin all the way to the place of the First **Gate**, all the way to the **Corner Gate**, and from the **Tower** of **Hananel** all the way to the press vats of the king. (**Zechariah 14:10**)

- Moreover, Uzziah **built** towers in Jerusalem by the **Corner Gate** and by the Valley **Gate** and by the Buttress, and made them strong. (**2 Chronicles 26:9**)
- And it was Amaziah the king of Judah the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah that Jehoash the king of Israel captured at Beth-shemesh, after which they came to Jerusalem and he made a breach in the wall of Jerusalem at the **Gate** of Ephraim clear to the **Corner Gate**, four hundred cubits. (**2 Kings 14:13**)
- And it was Amaziah the king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz, that Jehoash the king of Israel seized at Beth-shemesh, after which he brought him to Jerusalem and made a breach in the wall of Jerusalem, from the **Gate** of Ephraim clear to the **Corner Gate**, four hundred cubits. (**2 Chronicles 25:23**)
- And at your instance men **will certainly** build up the places devastated a long time, you **will** raise up even the foundations of continuous generations. And you **will** actually be called the repairer of the gap, the restorer of roadways by which to dwell. (**Isaiah 58:12**)
- In that day I shall make the sheiks of Judah like a firepot among trees and like a fiery torch in a row of newly cut grain, and they must devour on the right hand and on the left all the peoples round about, and Jerusalem must yet be inhabited in her own place, in Jerusalem. (**Zechariah 12:6**)
