Jeremiah 31:40... And all the low plain of the carcasses and of the fatty ashes, and all the terraces as far as the torrent valley of Kidron, clear to the corner of the Horse Gate<sup>1</sup> toward the sunrising, will be something holy to Yehowah. It will not be uprooted, neither will it be torn down anymore to time indefinite.

- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; In the same way I shall break this people and this city as someone breaks the vessel of the potter so that it is no more able to be repaired, and in Topheth they will bury until there is no more place to bury. (Jeremiah 19:11)
- Therefore, look! Days are coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, when it will no more be said to be Topheth and the valley of the son of Hinnom, but the valley of the killing, and they will have to bury in Topheth without there being enough place. (Jeremiah 7:32)
- And all the people of the land were weeping with a loud voice, and all the people were crossing over, and the king was standing by the torrent valley of Kidron, and all the people were crossing over upon the open road to the wilderness. (2 Samuel 15:23)
- Furthermore, he brought out the sacred pole from the house of Yehowah to the outskirts of Jerusalem, to the torrent valley of Kidron, and burned it in the torrent valley of Kidron and ground it to dust and cast its dust upon the burial place of the sons of the people. (2 Kings 23:6)
- Having said these things, Jesus went out with his disciples across the winter torrent of Kidron to where there was a garden, and he and his disciples entered into it. (John 18:1)
- So they laid their hands upon her and she came by the way of the horse entry of the king's house, and she got put to death there. (2 Kings 11:16)
- So they laid their hands upon her. When she came to the entry of the horse gate of the king's house, they at once put her to death there. (2 Chronicles 23:15)

- Above the Horse Gate the priests did repair work, each one in front of his own house. (Nehemiah 3:28)
- And when you people allot the land as an inheritance, you should offer a contribution to Yehowah, a holy portion out of the land, as to length, twenty-five thousand cubits in length, and as to width, ten thousand. It will be a holy portion in all its boundaries round about. (Ezekiel 45:1)
- And you people will have to know that I am Yehowah YOUR God, residing in Zion my holy mountain. And Jerusalem must become a holy place, and as regards strangers, they will no more pass through her. (Joel 3:17)
- This is what your Lord, Yehowah, even your God, who contends for his people, has said; Look! I will take away from your hand the cup causing reeling. The goblet, my cup of rage, you will not repeat the drinking of it anymore. (Isaiah 51:22)
- And people will certainly inhabit her, and there will occur no more any banning to destruction, and Jerusalem must be inhabited in security. (Zechariah 14:11)
