

Jeremiah 31:9 With weeping they will come, and with their entreaties for favor I shall bring them. I shall make them walk to torrent valleys of water, in a right way in which they will not be caused to stumble. For I have become to Israel a Father, and as for Ephraim, he is my firstborn.

- In those days and at that time, is the utterance of Yehowah, the sons of **Israel**, they and the sons of Judah together, **will come**. They **will walk**, weeping as they **walk**, and for Yehowah their God they **will** seek. (**Jeremiah 50:4**)
- And the heat-parched ground **will have become** as a reedy pool, and the thirsty ground as springs of **water**. In the abiding place of jackals, a resting-place for them, there **will** be green grass with reeds and papyrus plants. (**Isaiah 35:7**)
- They **will** not go hungry, neither **will** they go thirsty, nor **will** parching heat or sun strike them. For the One who is having pity upon them **will** lead them, and by the springs of **water** he **will** conduct them. (**Isaiah 49:10**)
- Is it to Yehowah that **you** keep doing this **way**, O people stupid and not wise? Is he not your **Father** who has produced you, He who made you and proceeded to give you stability? (**Deuteronomy 32:6**)
- However, **Israel** put out his **right** hand and placed it on Ephraim's head, although he was the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head. He purposely laid his hands so, since Manasseh was the firstborn. (**Genesis 48:14**)
- And you must say to Pharaoh; This is what Yehowah has said; Israel is my son, my firstborn. (**Exodus 4:22**)
- But his father kept refusing and said; I know it, my son, I know it. He too **will become** a people and he too **will become** great. But, just the same, his younger brother **will become** greater than he **will**, and his offspring **will become** the full equivalent of nations. (**Genesis 48:19**)
- Those sowing seed with tears **will** reap even with a joyful cry. (**Psalms 126:5**)

- The wild beast of the field **will** glorify me, the jackals and the ostriches, because I shall **have** given **water** even in the wilderness, rivers in the desert, to cause my people, my chosen one, to drink. (**Isaiah 43:20**)
- Have you from now on called out to me; My **Father**, you are the confidential friend of my youth! (**Jeremiah 3:4**)
- I **have** positively heard **Ephraim** bemoaning himself; You **have** corrected me, that I may be corrected, like a calf that has not been trained. Cause me to turn back, and I shall readily turn back, for you are Yehowah my God. (**Jeremiah 31:18**)
- Is **Ephraim** a precious son to me, or a fondly treated child? For to the extent of my speaking against him I shall without fail remember him further. That is why my intestines **have become** boisterous for him. By all means I shall **have** pity upon him, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 31:20**)
- And those of **Ephraim** must **become** just like a mighty man, and their heart must rejoice as though from wine. And their own sons **will** see and certainly rejoice, their heart **will** be joyful in Yehowah. (**Zechariah 10:7**)
- And I **will** pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of **favor** and **entreaties**, and they **will** certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they **will** certainly wail over Him as in the wailing over an only son, and there **will** be a bitter lamentation over him as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (**Zechariah 12:10**)
