- Preserving **loving-kindness** for **thousands**, pardoning **error** and transgression and sin, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the **error** of **fathers** upon **sons** and upon grandsons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (**Exodus 34:7**)
- **Yehowah**, slow to anger and abundant in **loving-kindness**, pardoning **error** and transgression, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the **error** of the **fathers** upon **sons**, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (**Numbers 14:18**)
- You must not bow down to them or be led to serve them, because I **Yehowah** your **God** am a **God** exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the **error** of **fathers** upon **sons** and upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Deuteronomy 5:9**)
- For that reason here I am bringing calamity upon the house of Jeroboam, and I shall certainly cut off from Jeroboam anyone urinating against a wall, a helpless and worthless one in Israel, and I shall indeed make a clean sweep behind the house of Jeroboam, just as one clears away the dung until it is disposed of. (**1 Kings 14:10**)
- Look! It is written before me. I shall not keep still, but I will render a reward, I will even render the reward into their own **bosom**. (**Isaiah 65:6**)

- And I went on to say; Ah, **Yehowah** the **God** of the heavens, the **God great** and fear-inspiring, keeping the covenant and **loving-kindness toward** those loving him and keeping his commandments. (**Nehemiah 1:5**)
- For **Yehowah** **YOUR God** is the **God** of gods and the Lord of lords, the **God great, mighty** and fear-inspiring, who treats none with partiality nor accepts a bribe. (**Deuteronomy 10:17**)

- But **exercising loving-kindness toward** the thousandth generation in the case of those who love me and keep my commandments. (**Deuteronomy 5:10**)
- Look! **God** is **mighty** and will not reject, he is **mighty** in power of heart. (**Job 36:5**)
- The Divine **One, God, Yehowah**, has himself spoken, and he proceeds to call the earth, from the rising of the sun until its setting. (**Psalms 50:1**)
- And repay to our neighbors seven times into their **bosom** their reproach with which they have reproached you, O **Yehowah**. (**Psalms 79:12**)
- For **Yehowah** is **great** and very much to be praised. He is fear-inspiring above all other gods. (**Psalms 96:4**)
- **Yehowah** is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in **loving-kindness**. (**Psalms 103:8**)

- Praise him for his works of mightiness. Praise him according to the abundance of his greatness. (**Psalms 150:2**)
- In no way is there anyone like you, O **Yehowah**. You are **great**, and your **name** is **great** in mightiness. (**Jeremiah 10:6**)
- This is what **Yehowah** the Maker of earth has said, **Yehowah** the Former of it to establish it firmly, **Yehowah** being his **name**. (**Jeremiah 33:2**)
- Daniel was answering and saying; Let the **name** of **God** become blessed from time indefinite even to time indefinite, for wisdom and mightiness, for they belong to him. (**Daniel 2:20**)
