Jeremiah 32:21. And you proceeded to bring forth your people Israel out of the land of Egypt, with signs and with miracles and with a strong hand and with a stretched-out arm and with great fearsomeness.

- Therefore say to the sons of Israel; I am Yehowah, and I shall certainly bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians and deliver you from their slavery, and I shall indeed reclaim you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. (Exodus 6:6)
- And it must occur that in case your son should inquire of you later on, saying, What does this mean? Then you must say to him. By strength of hand Yehowah brought us out of Egypt, from the house of slaves. (Exodus 13:14)
- They set among them the matters of his signs, and the miracles in the land of Ham. (Psalms 105:27)
- Accordingly he rebuked the Red Sea, and it was gradually dried up, and he went walking them through the watery deep as through the wilderness. (Psalms 106:9)
- So Yehowah said to Moses; Now you will see what I shall do to Pharaoh, because on account of a strong hand he will send them away and on account of a strong hand he will drive them out of his land. (Exodus 6:1)
- Your right hand, O Yehowah, is proving itself powerful in ability. Your right hand, O Yehowah, can shatter an enemy. (Exodus 15:6)
- Finally Yehowah brought us out of Egypt with a strong hand and an outstretched arm and with great fearsomeness and with signs and miracles. (Deuteronomy 26:8)
- And what other nation in the earth is like your people Israel, whom the true God went to redeem to himself as a people, to assign to yourself a name of great achievements and fearinspiring things by driving out nations from before your people whom you have redeemed from Egypt? (1 Chronicles 17:21)
- By a strong hand and by an arm stretched out, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:12)

- Or did God attempt to come to take a nation to himself out of the midst of another nation with provings, with signs and with miracles and with war and with a strong hand and with an outstretched arm and with great fearsomeness like all that Yehowah Your God has done for You in Egypt before your eyes? (Deuteronomy 4:34)
- And yet you continue to live, because he loved your forefathers so that he chose their seed after them and brought you out of Egypt in his sight with his great power. (Deuteronomy 4:37)
- But Yehowah, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt with great power and a stretched-out arm, is the One whom you should fear, and to him you should bow down, and to him you should sacrifice. (2 Kings 17:36)
- And Yehowah did not want to bring the house of David to ruin, for the sake of the covenant that he had concluded with David, and just as he had said he would give him and his sons a lamp always. (2 Chronicles 21:7)
